STEP 14.1 Open the door.



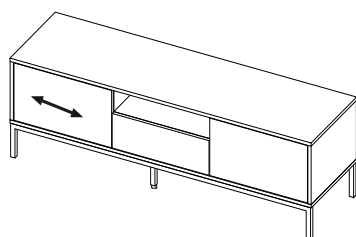
STEP 14.2 Adjust the door panels upward or downward



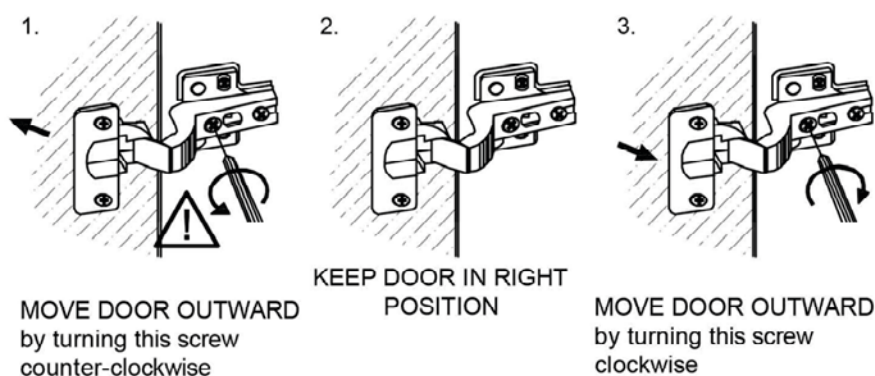
1. Unscrew 2 screws in round holes

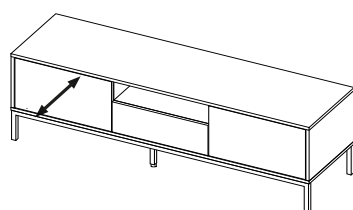

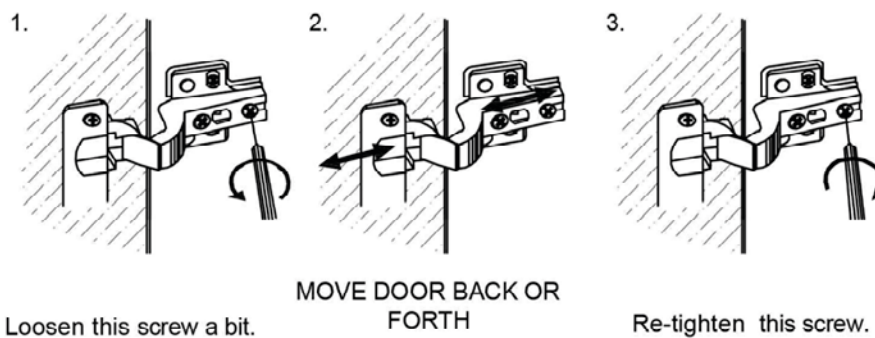
